Village concept sets a new standard

The new Richmond Village, with its pleasant architecture and compact and leisurely shopping facilities, is an ideal area for local and visiting customers to enjoy the efficient, personal service offered by friendly shopkeepers and staff.

Ample parking is available from four entrances off three different streets — Stanmore Rd, North Avon Rd and Avalon St.

"The village concept is a far cry from the limited facilities the area has been able to offer over the last 70 years or so," said Roy Burn, of North Avon Shoe Store (a long-established family business in Stanmore Rd).

Mr Burn said that 50 years ago established shops included Tucks Ltd, McKenzies Drapery, Straw's Butchery (still operating in North Avon Rd, but with many changes of owners over five decades), Dr Cropp's surgery (formerly a haberdashery shop owned by the Church sisters), Moore's Dairy (now known as the Mecca Fruit and Veges), Mitchell's Greengrocers (later to be taken over by Woonacotts), Richmond Cycles, Young's Grocery, the Corner Dairy and Anne Hine's chemist shop (taken over by Roger Prebble and now operating in the new Richmond Shopping Village).

"Apart from those already mentioned — all of which, with the exception of the butcher, were in the main Stanmore Rd block — there was a three-shop block on the corner of Stanmore Rd and Avalon St," said Mr Burn.

"The most southern shop I remember was Farrow's Butchery, taken over later by Eric McPherson, who then moved to North Avon Rd. His vacated shop eventually became a bookshop, a second hand shop and is now a greengrocer's."

"My most vivid memory of the corner shop — then a Self-Help outlet and now a modern restaurant — was of its north wall, on which was painted a large elephant complete with rider (the symbol of Self-Help tea). As a child I spent many hours using this wall as a volley board

— with no regard for the signwriting.

"The centre shop — between Farrow's and the Self-Help — was occupied in 1937 by the North Avon Post Office.

"A site was reserved for a new post office between Warwick and Vogel Sts, but due to negotiations between Richmond shopkeepers and the Chief Post Office, this was relinquished in favour of the present site.

"Where the Post Office now stands, as many will remember, was a blacksmith's shop owned by a Mr Dave Harries. When Dave retired he was reluctant to sell, but he finally gave way — once again through the negotiation of Richmond shopkeepers."

Where the impressive premises of Richmond Electrical now stands was formerly a drycleaners for some years. Originally this was a footwear repair business owned by a Mr Corkery (taken over by Albert Burn about 1928). The Burn family can therefore be said to have found a "footing" in Richmond for more than 50 years.

"On the east side of Stanmore Rd, three shops built many years ago are still operating, but they have seen numerous changes in ownership and in the type of merchandise offered.

"Apart from my own North Avon Shoe Store, there are two long-established family businesses still going strong — from strength to strength in fact."

Horgan's hairdressing and tobacconist business was started when Jim Horgan bought out Les Kingston (the previous barber in the district in 1939). Son Frank took over this business in 1948 and his father opened a jeweller's shop next door, which he ran with his wife for 10 years or so.

The jeweller's shop closed down after Jim's death and the premises were taken over by Richmond Electrical.

Frank Horgan and his wife have completely remodelled the hairdressing business — now known as Shop One — and it is a unique combination of unisex hair salon and old-fashioned barber and tobacconist.

The other family business in the area, Richmond Electrical, is operated by Denis Rich and was started by his father, Hermie Rich, in 1949 on the corner of Petrie St and North Avon Rd. It progressed to larger

premises in Stanmore Rd and is now a Richmond landmark in its spacious modern store further along Stanmore Rd.

"Richmond Village caters for most of the requirements of the complete shopper — electrical and fancy goods, post office, supermarket, footwear and bags, wines, fruit and vegetables, meat, fresh and frozen fish, chemist, frozen foods, drapery and women's apparel, hairdressing for men, women and children, paint and garden centre, fish and pet supplies and plant nursery, delicatessen and tea rooms, cycles, hardware, dentist and boutique.
